Mihaela Nistor has served in leadership roles related to data and risk management in the financial and fintech sectors for nearly 20 years. In May 2023, she was named Chief Risk Officer of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, which she will join in June 2023.

Previously, Ms. Nistor was the Global Head of Enterprise Risk Management at Bloomberg LP, where she designed and implemented the company's Enterprise Risk Management Program by incorporating technology innovation and a data-driven approach. In that role, she worked closely with software engineers to develop methodologies for collecting information, leverage machine learning for data analytics, create self-service visualization tools, and optimize processes and operations. Her responsibilities also include managing the company's access control and privileging security program, as well as developing long-term strategies for data protection and governance.

Prior to Bloomberg, Ms. Nistor was Chief Risk Officer Private Bank Americas for HSBC Bank USA. In this role, she was responsible for risk oversight and governance for all the Private Bank activities in the Americas and coordination with centralized HSBC Group Risk Functions. She has also held several compliance and risk leadership roles at HSBC and, prior to that, at Citigroup Private Bank.

Ms. Nistor holds a master's degree in international finance and business from Columbia University and a bachelor's degree in business management from Marymount Manhattan College. She has also completed the General Management Program at Harvard Business School.
