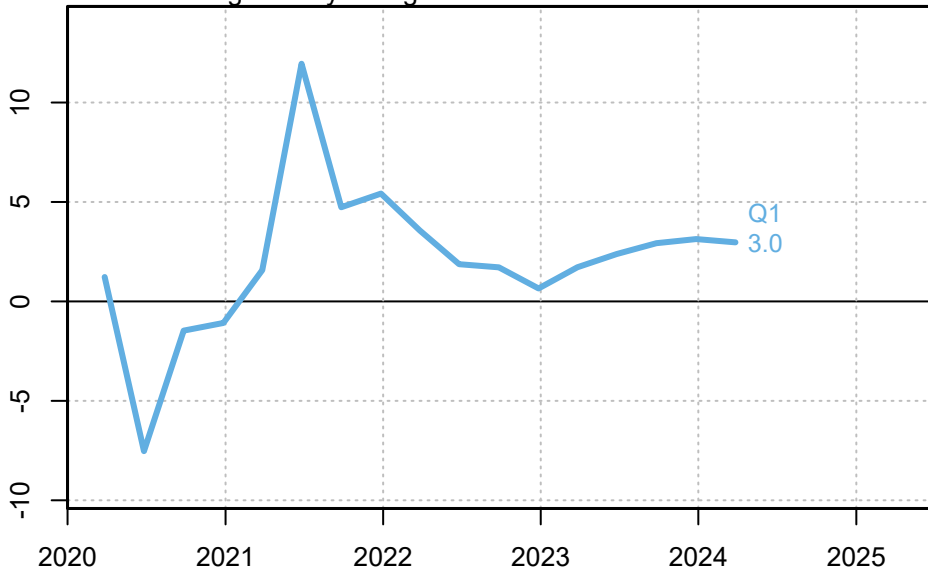

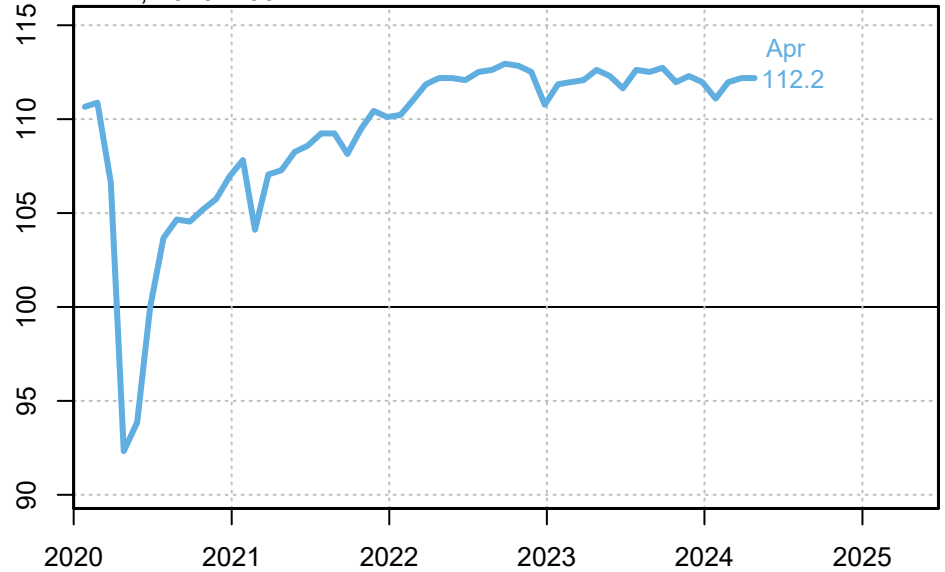

Percent change over year-ago level



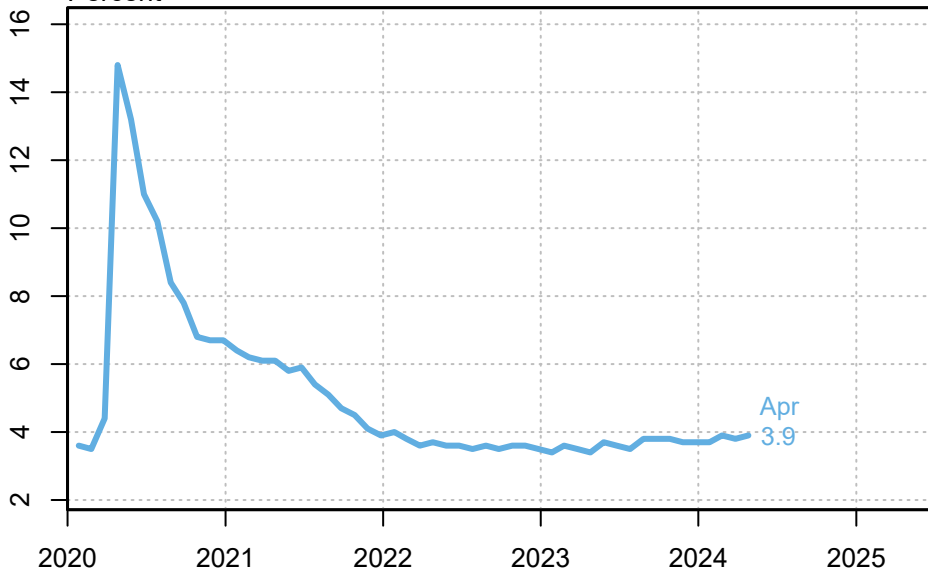
Industrial Production

Index, 2010=100



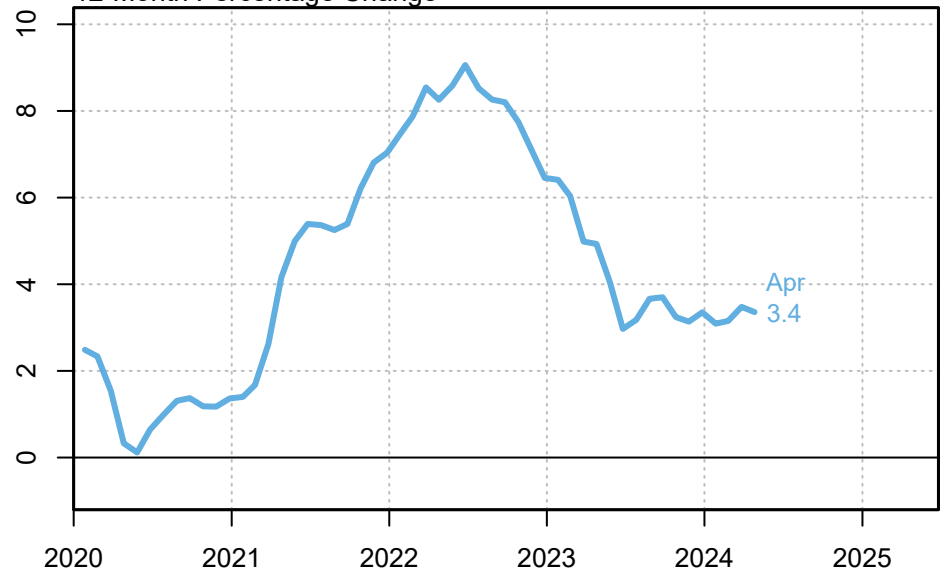

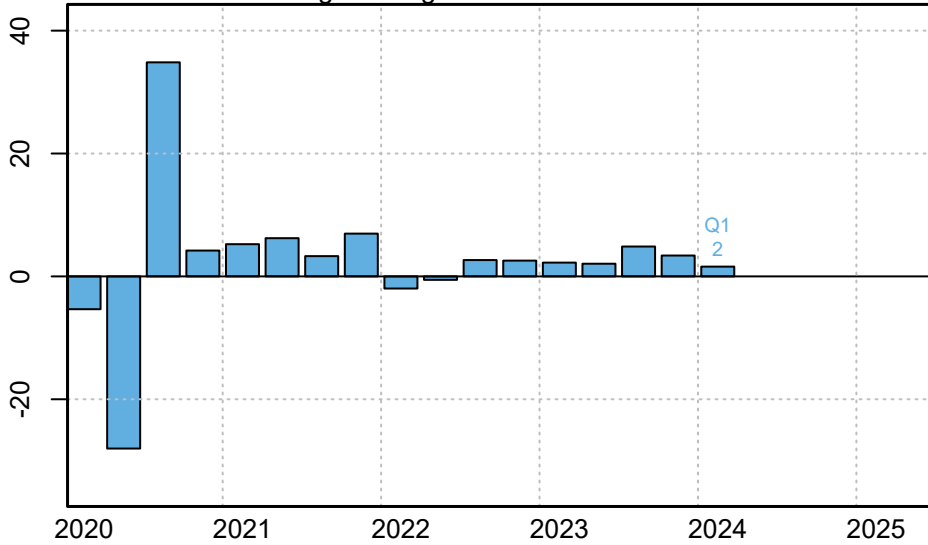

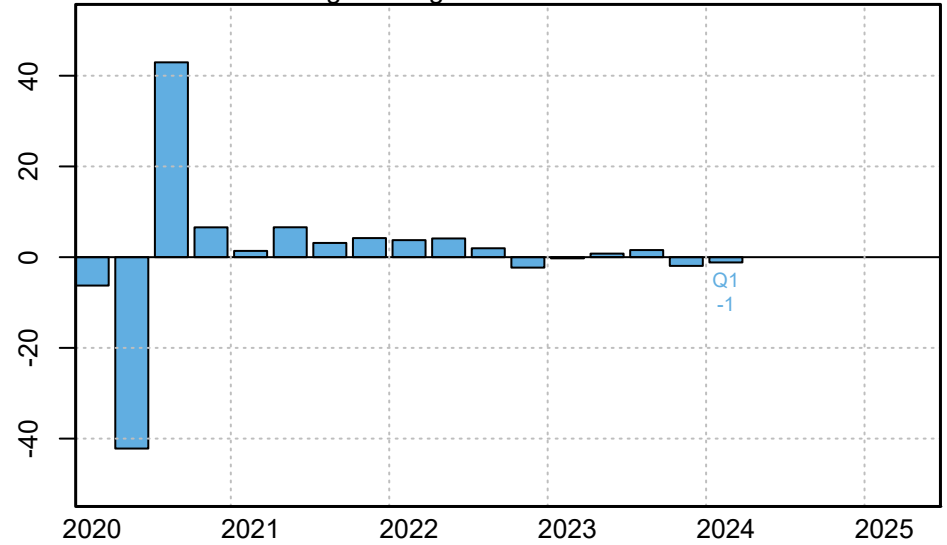

Annualized Percentage Change



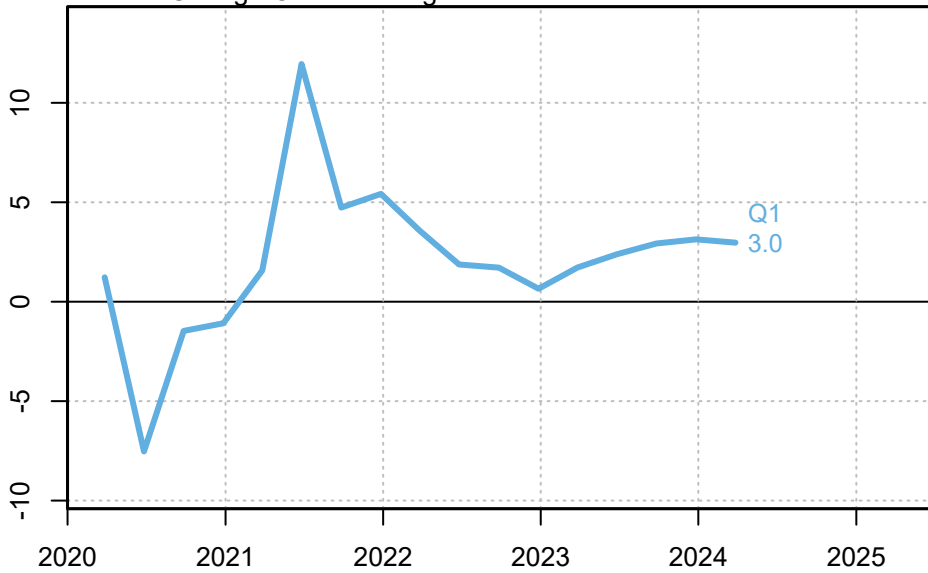

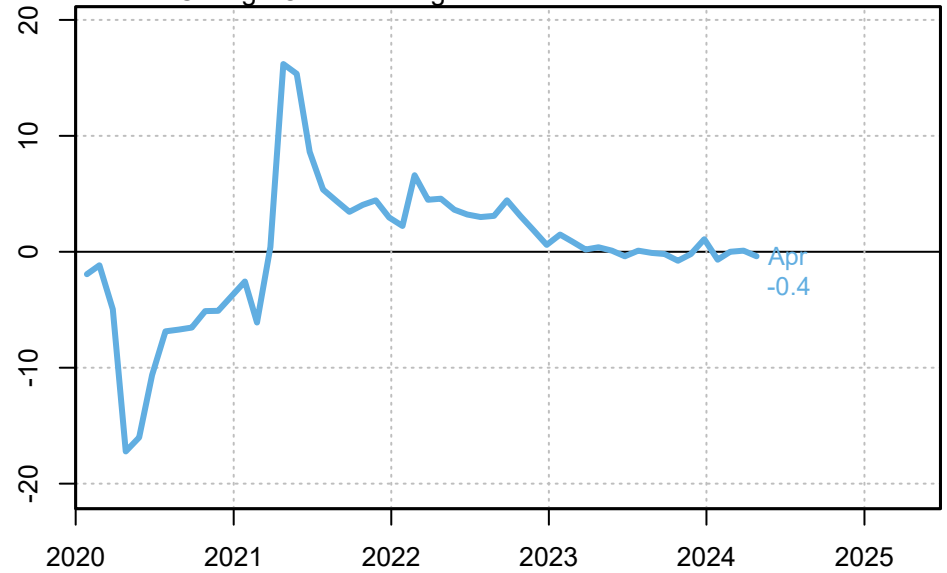

Percent Change Over Year-Ago Level



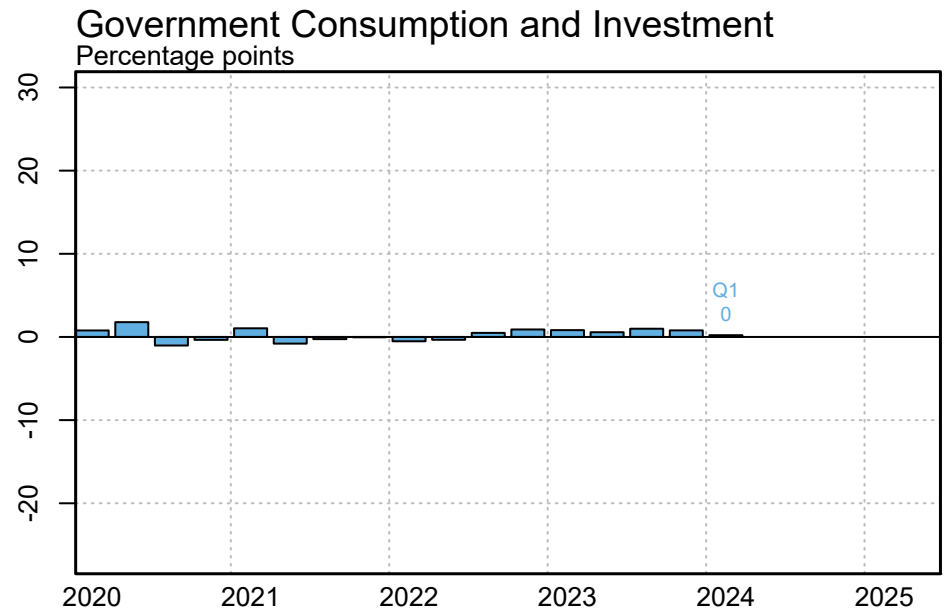
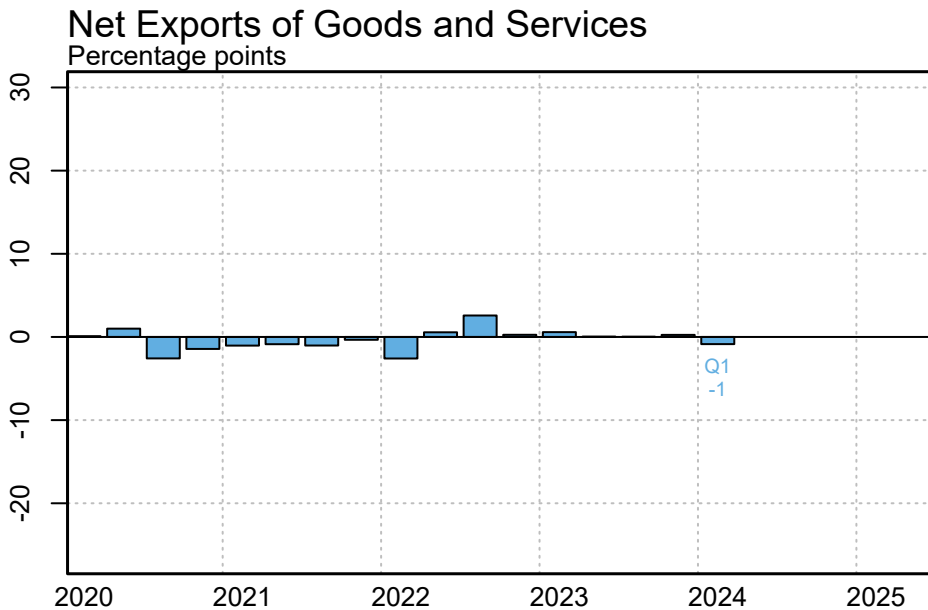
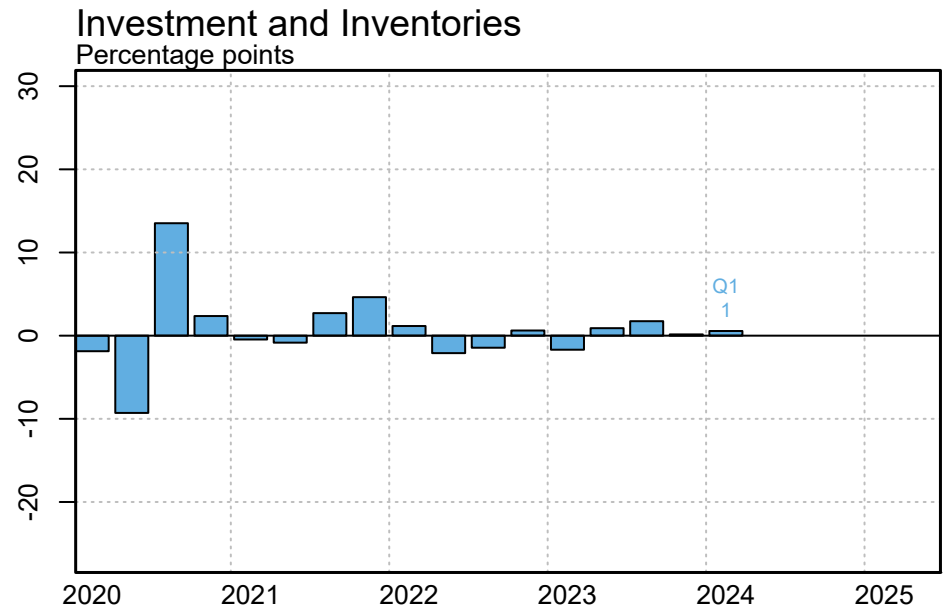
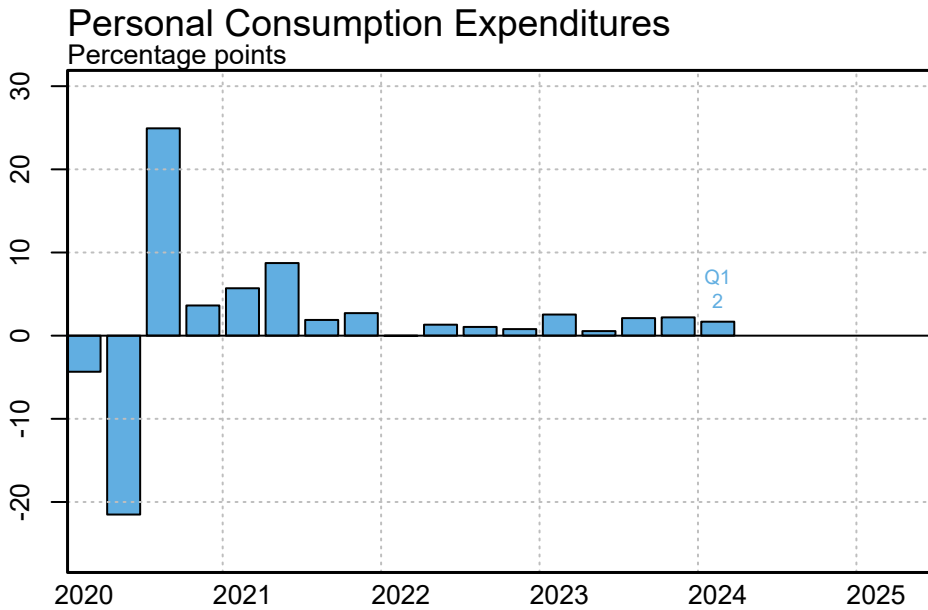

Contribution to Change in GDP (1)



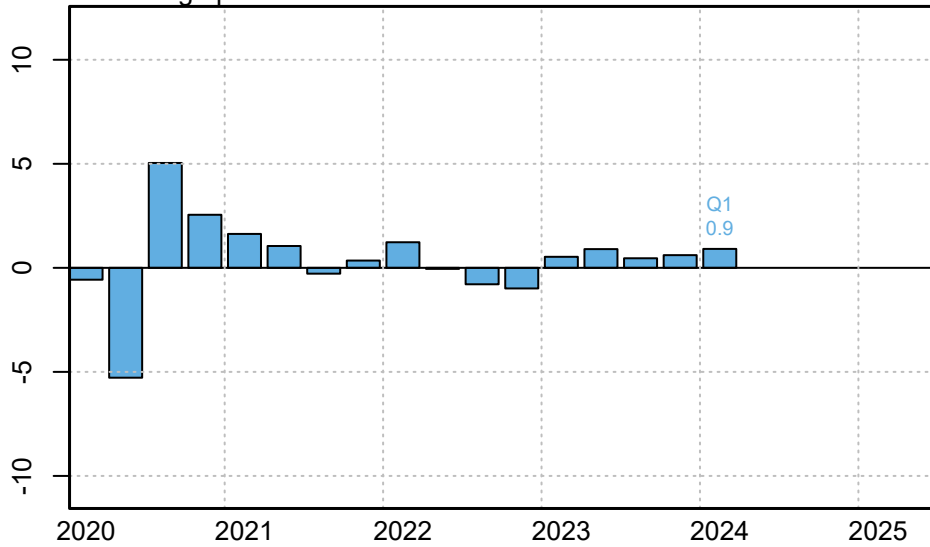

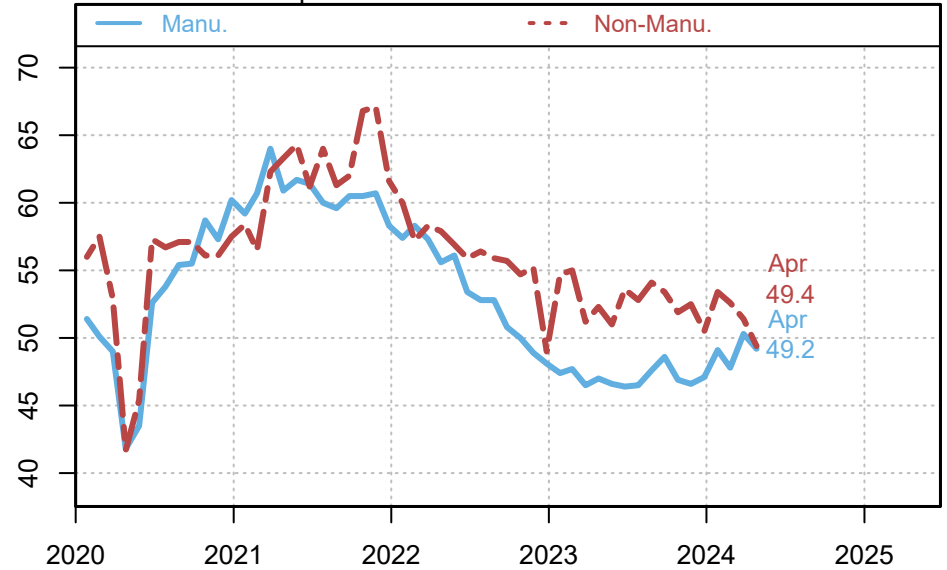
Leading Indicators Composite Index

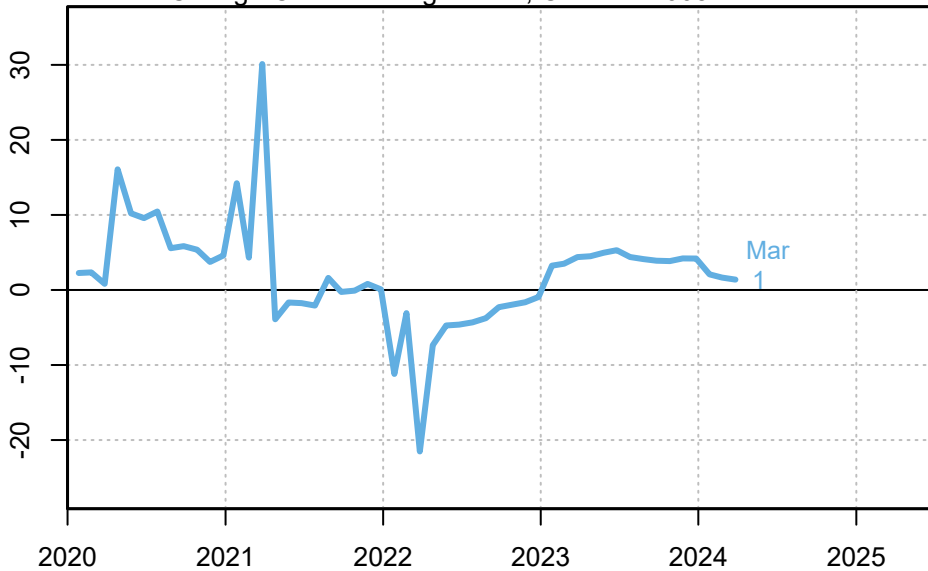

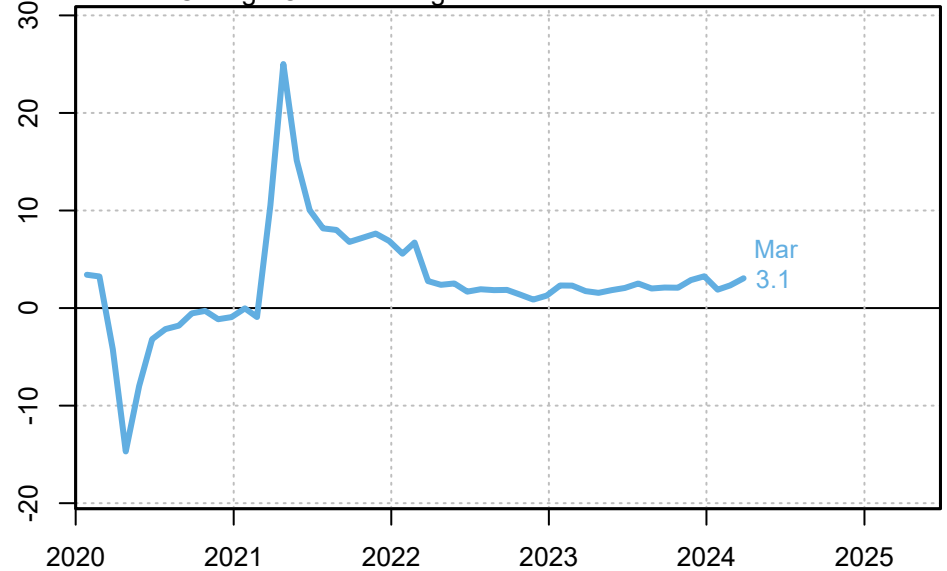
Real Personal Disposable Income

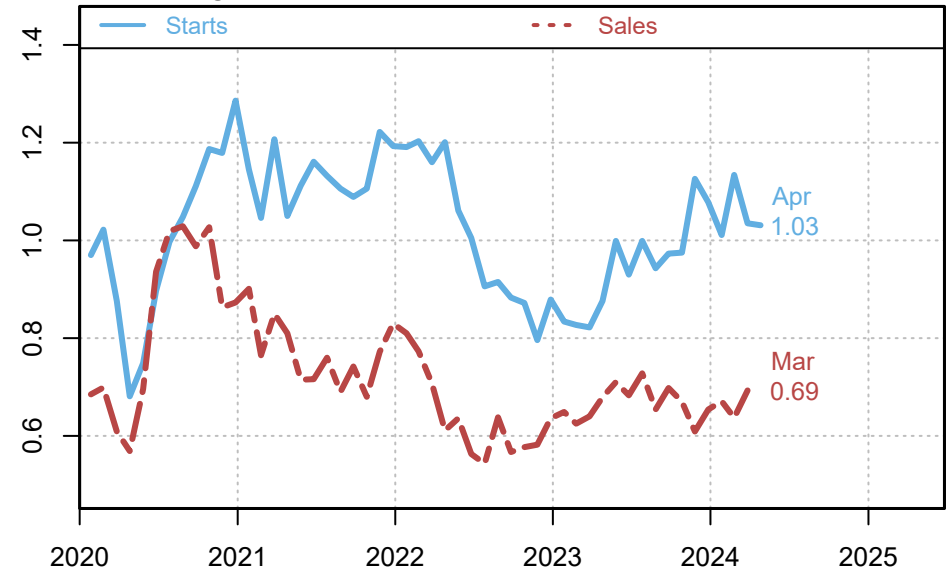

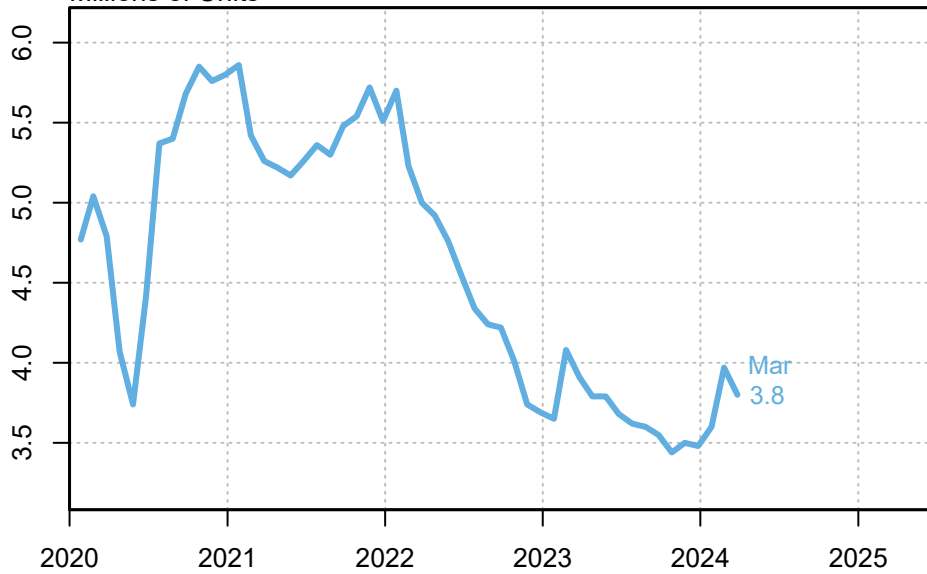

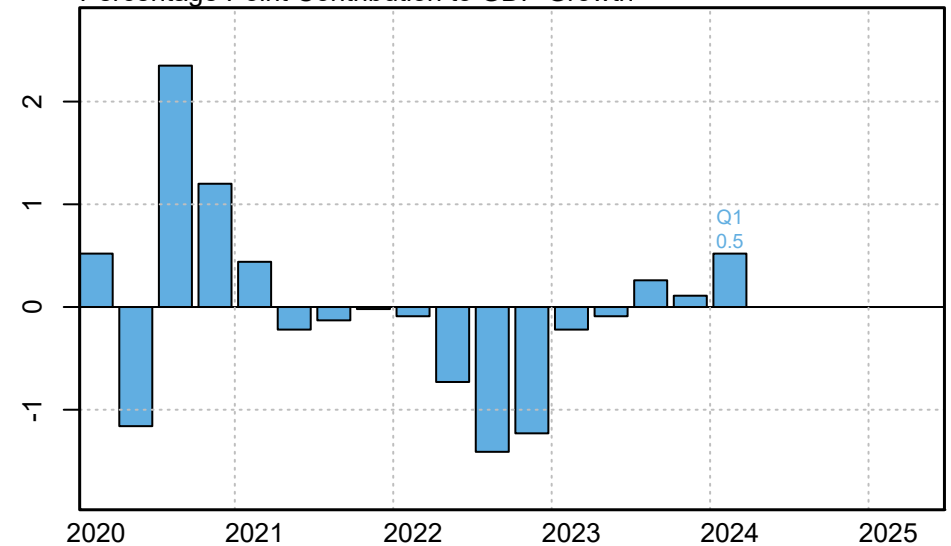
Existing Single Family Home Sales

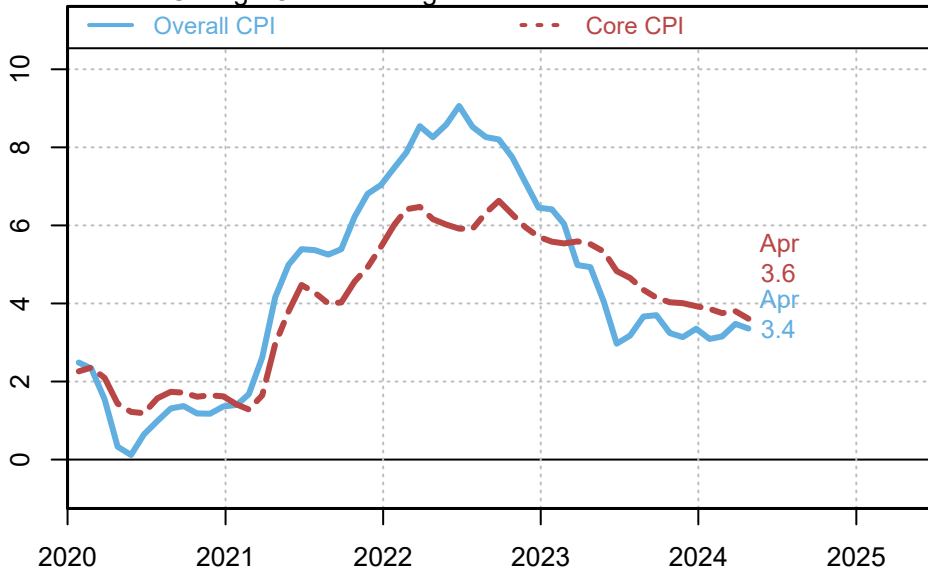

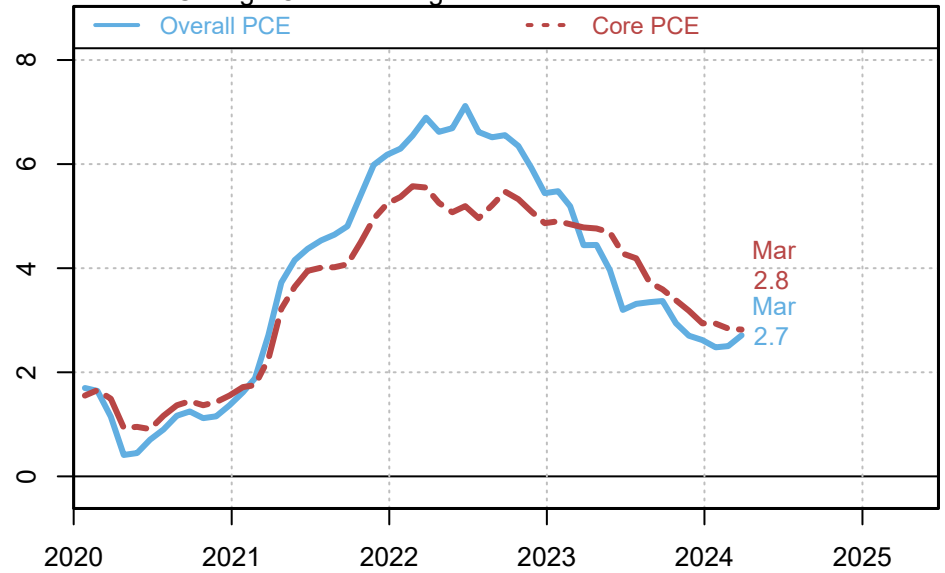

Percent Change Over Year-Ago Level



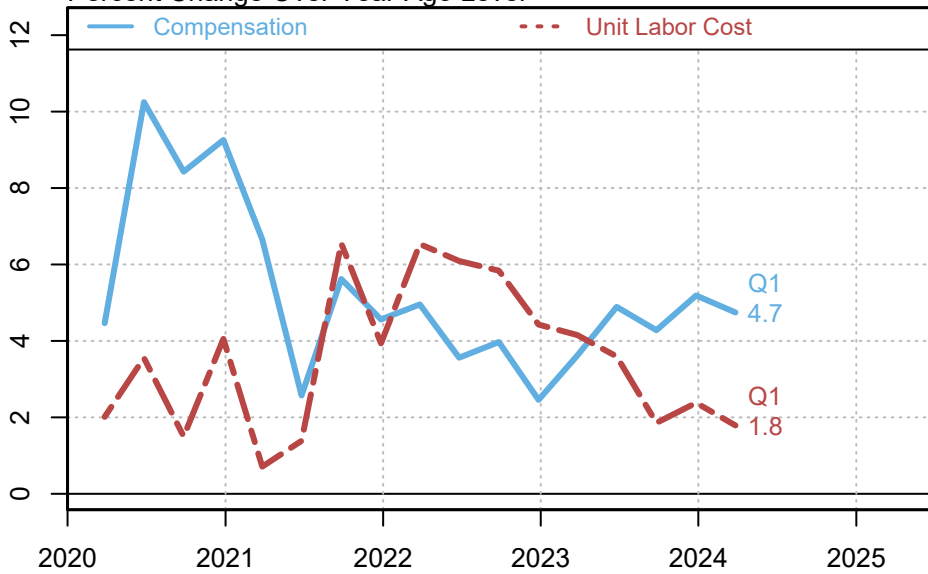
Personal Consumption Expenditure

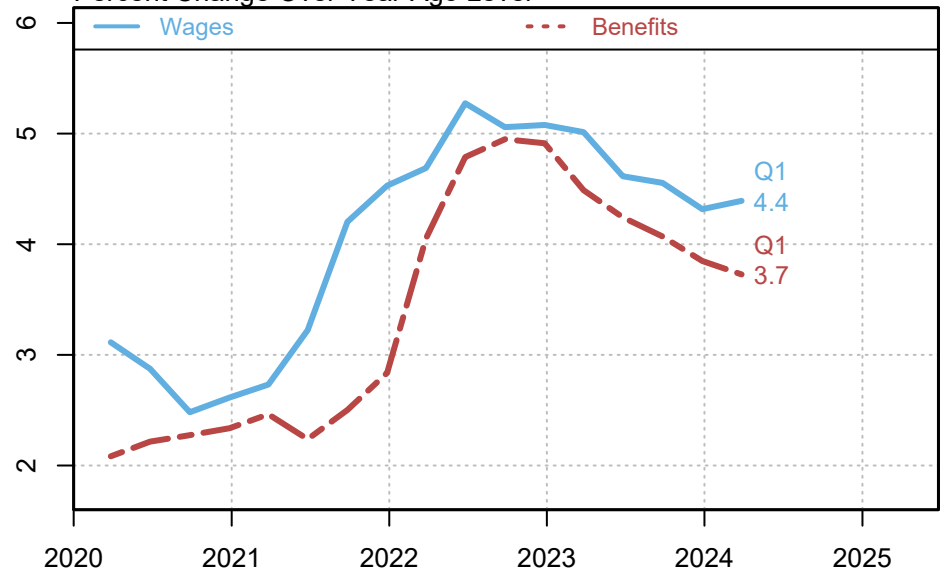
Compensation per Hour and Unit Labor Cost

Net Export Contribution to Real GDP

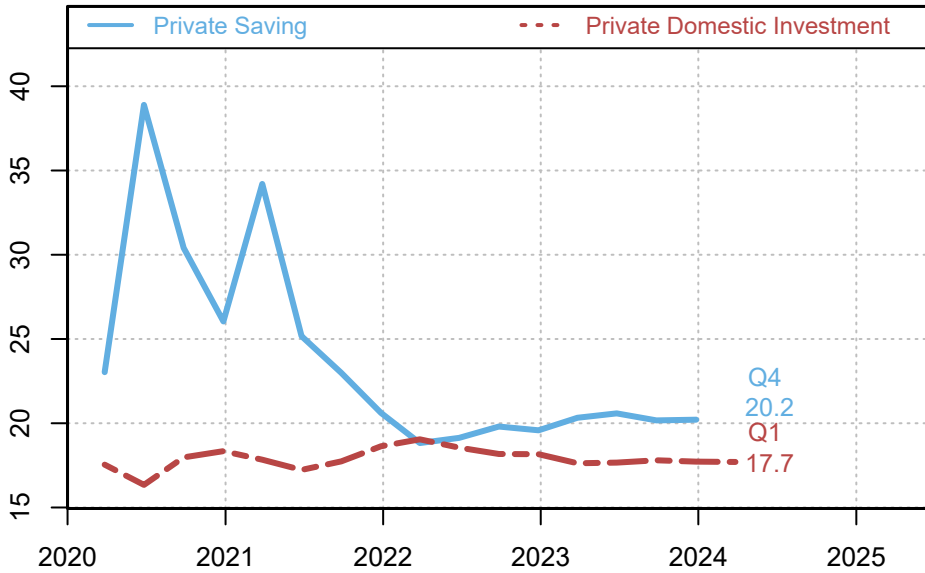

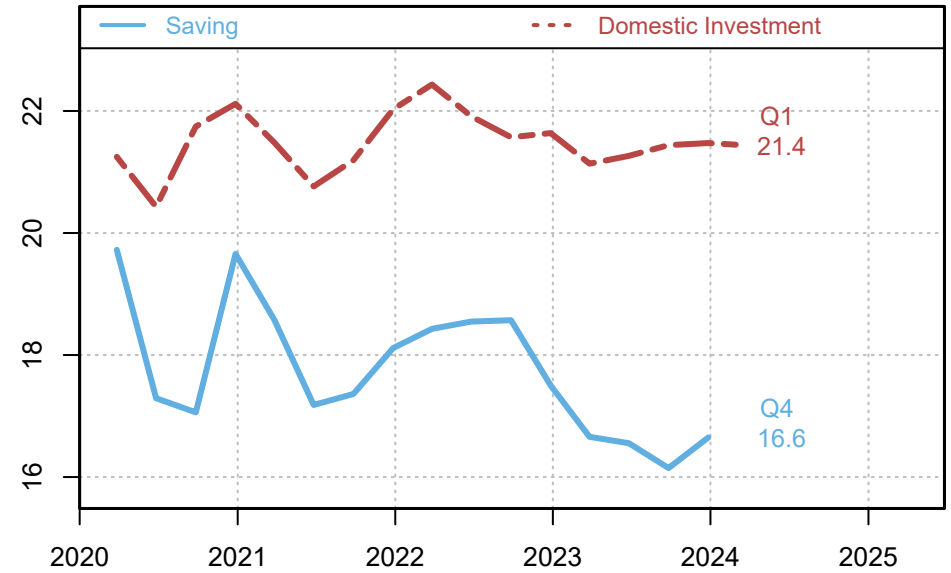

Gross Saving and Investment as a Percent of Nominal GDP

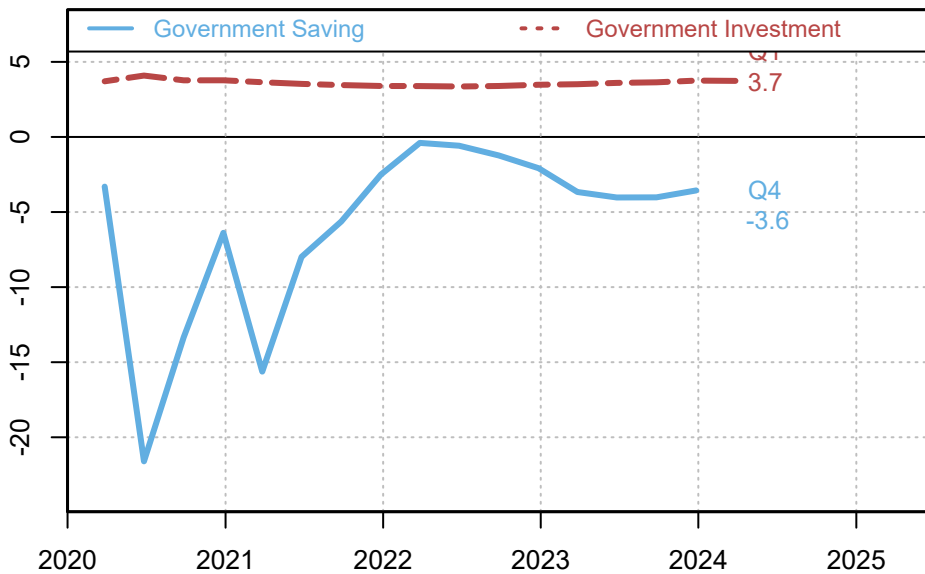

3-month Treasury Bill Rate, 10-year Treasury Yield



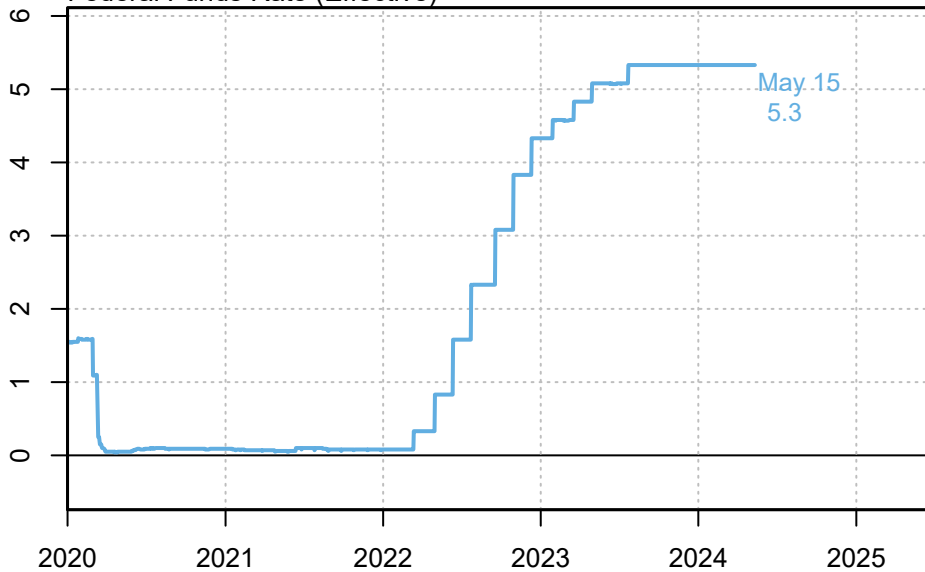

Major Currency Index, 2010=100



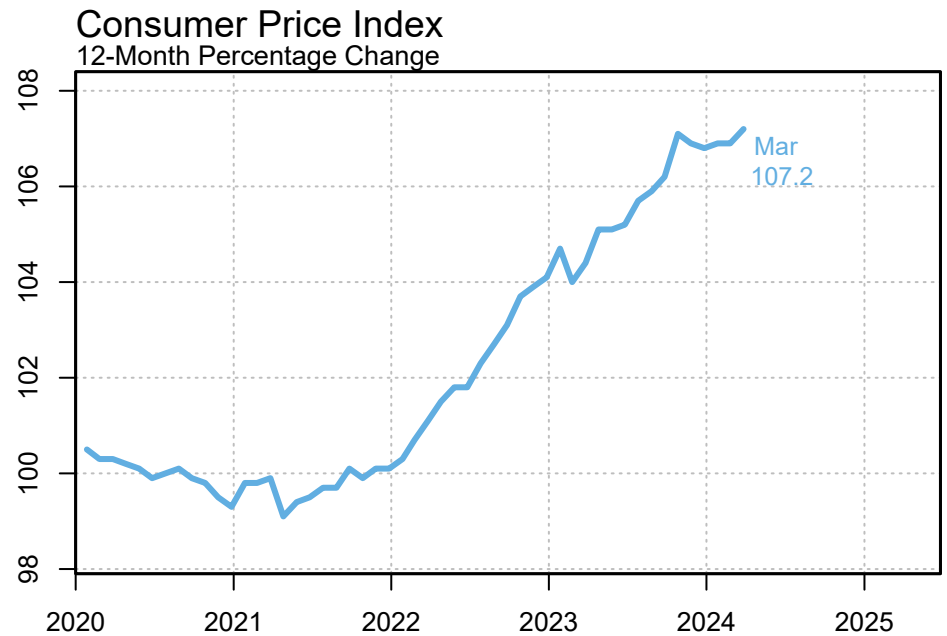
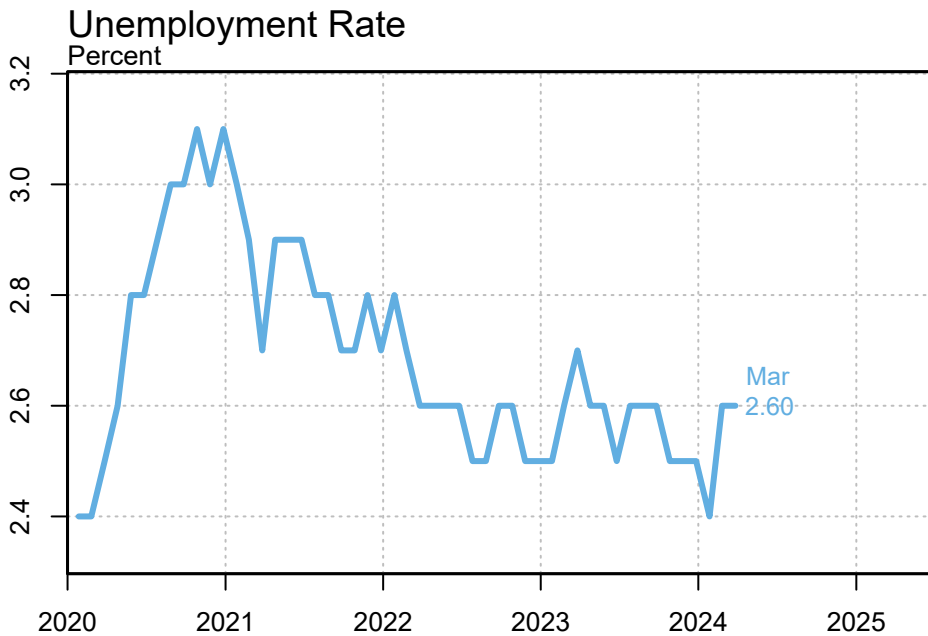
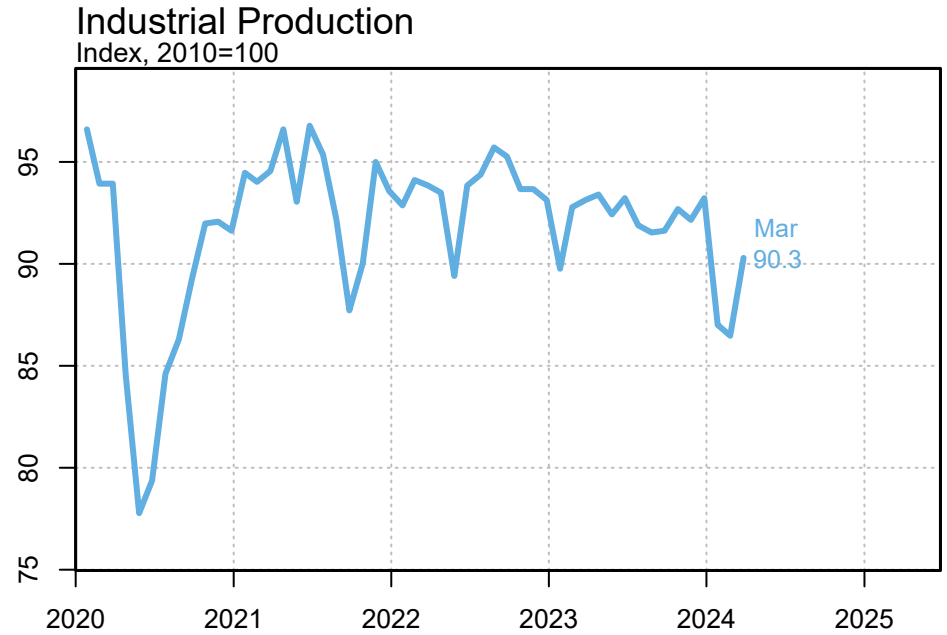
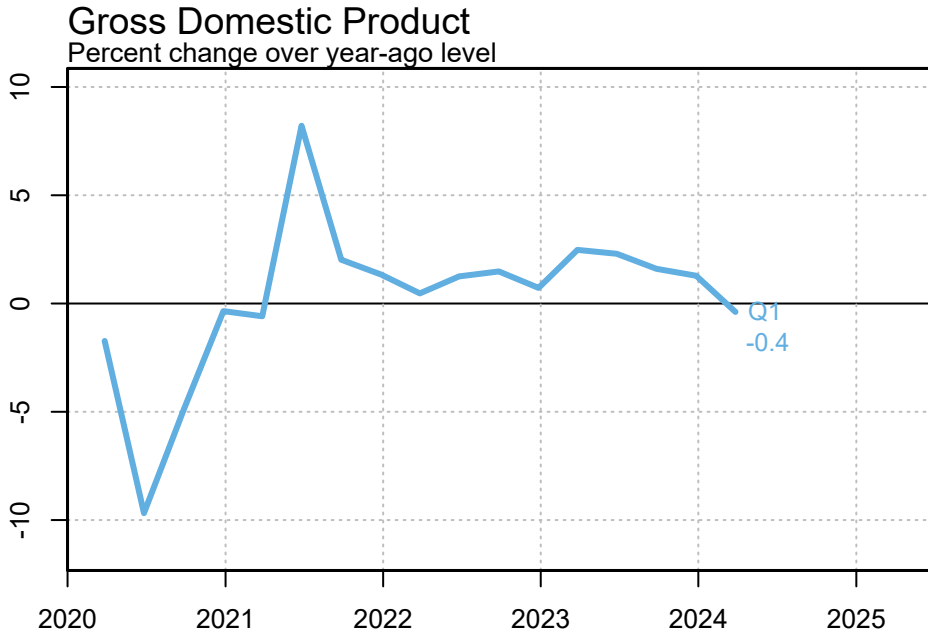

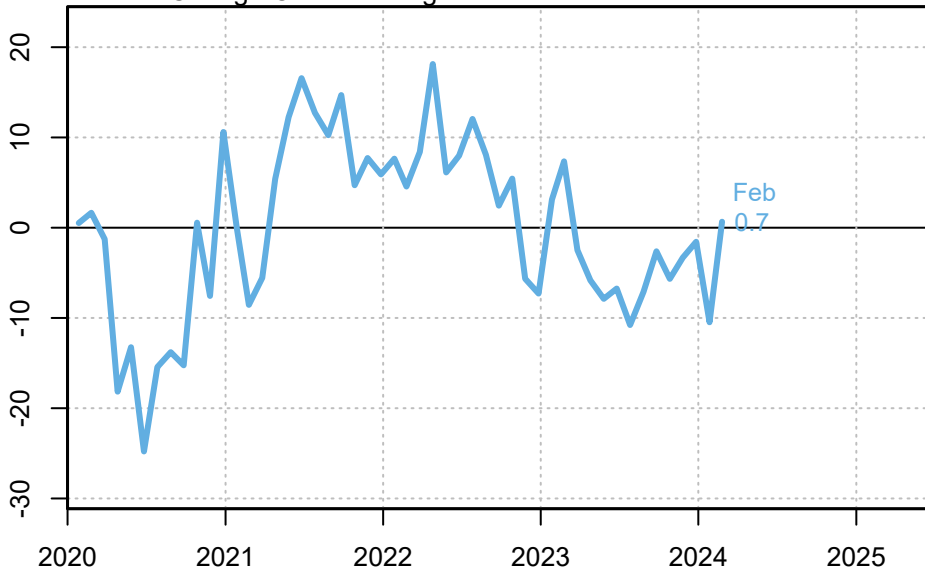
Manufacturing Producers' Shipments

Percent Change Over Year-Ago Level



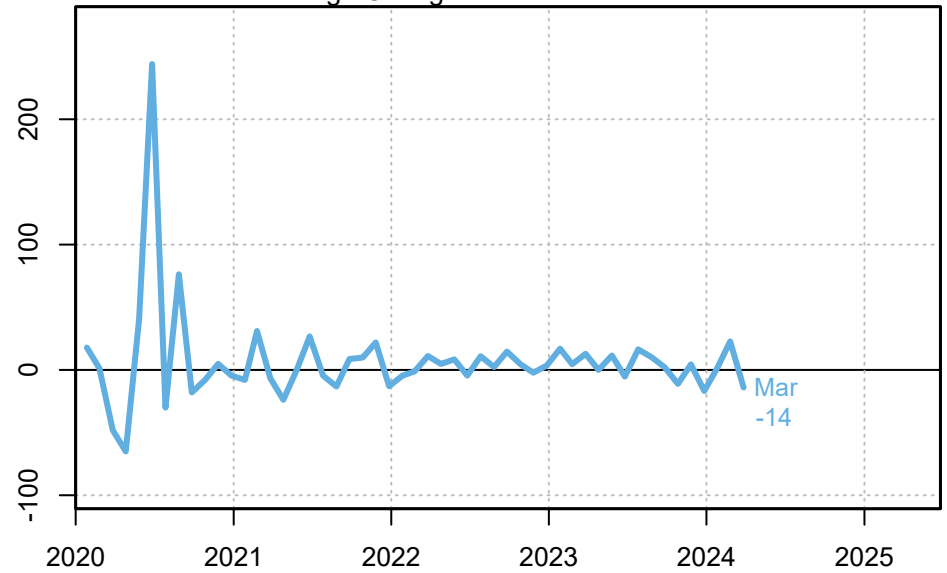

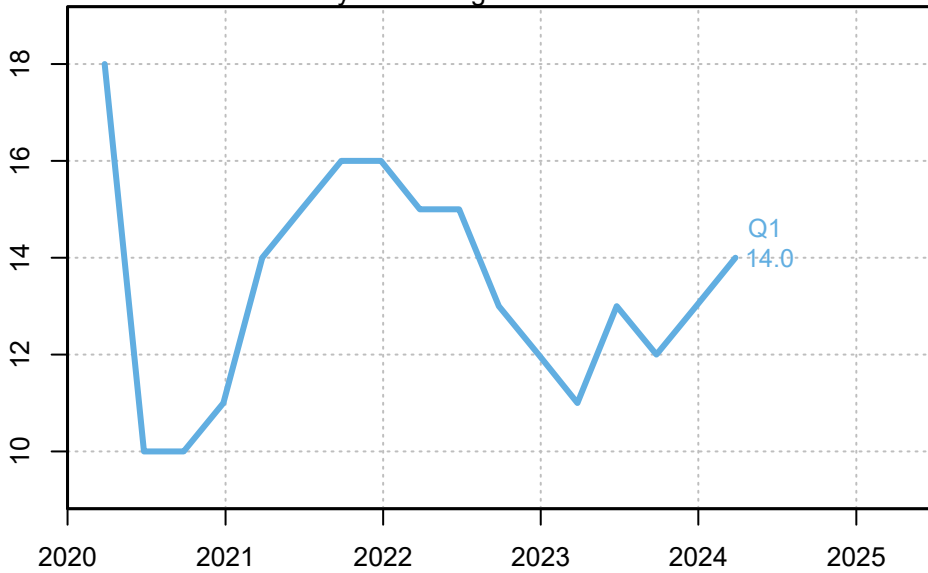

Net Percentage 'Favorable' responses



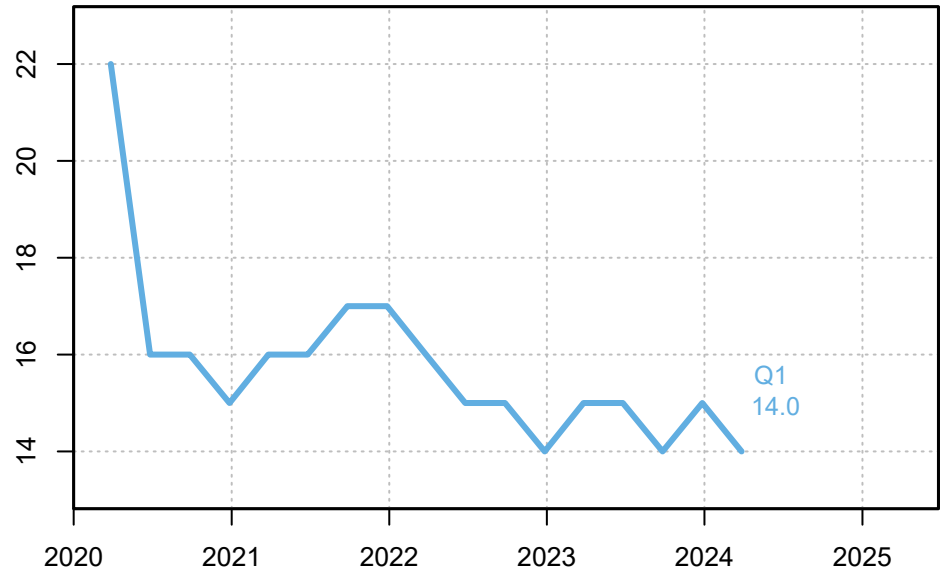

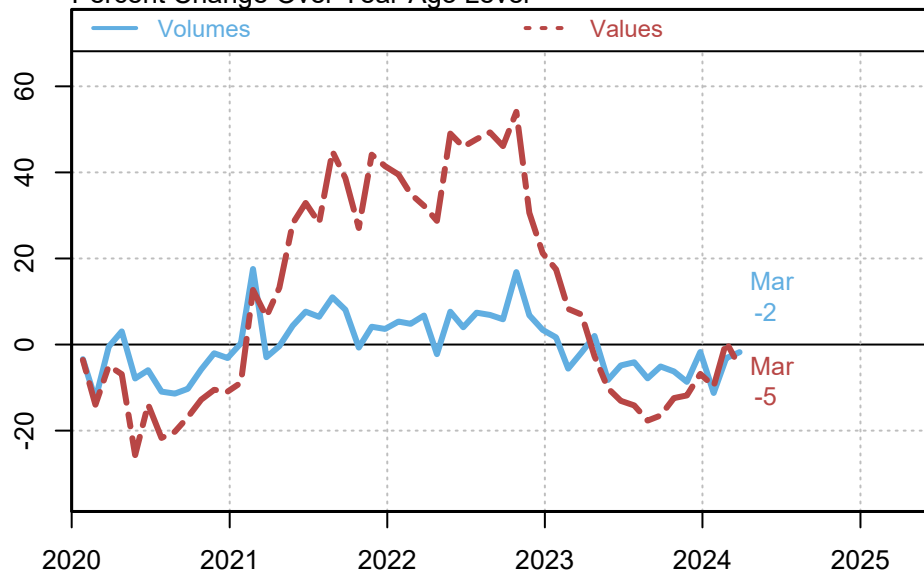
Trade and Current Account Balances

In Billions of Dollars, SAAR



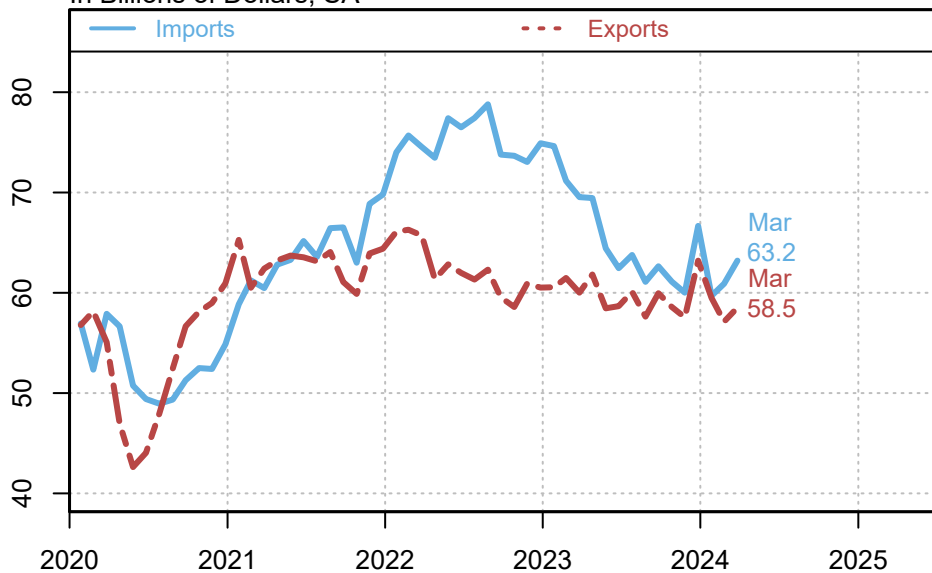
Merchandise Imports

Percent Change Over Year-Ago Level



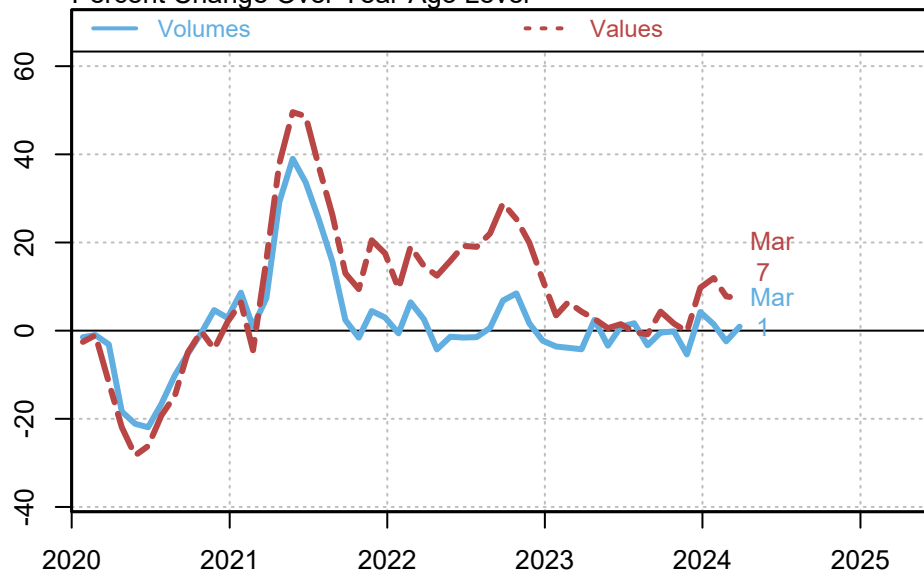

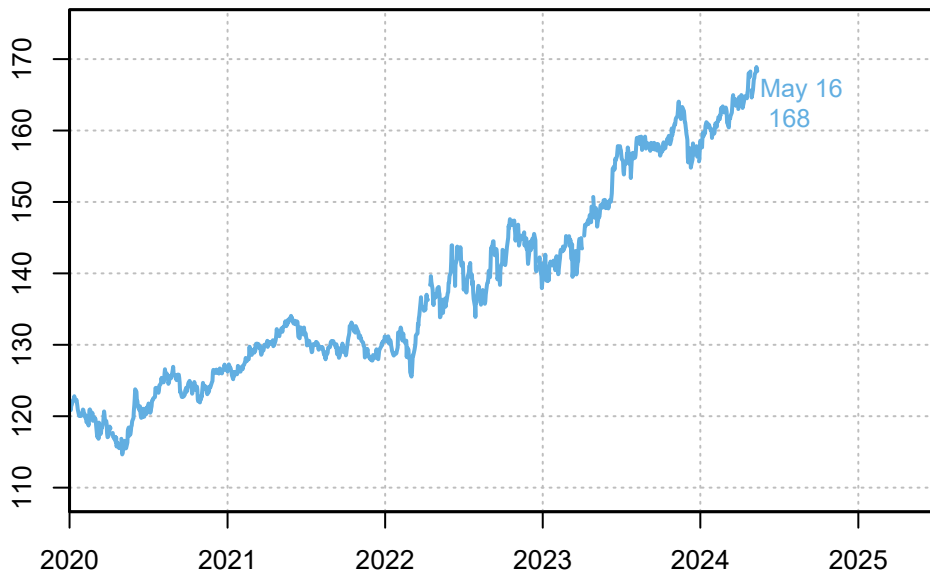


Nominal Effective Exchange Rate

Broad Index, 2010=100

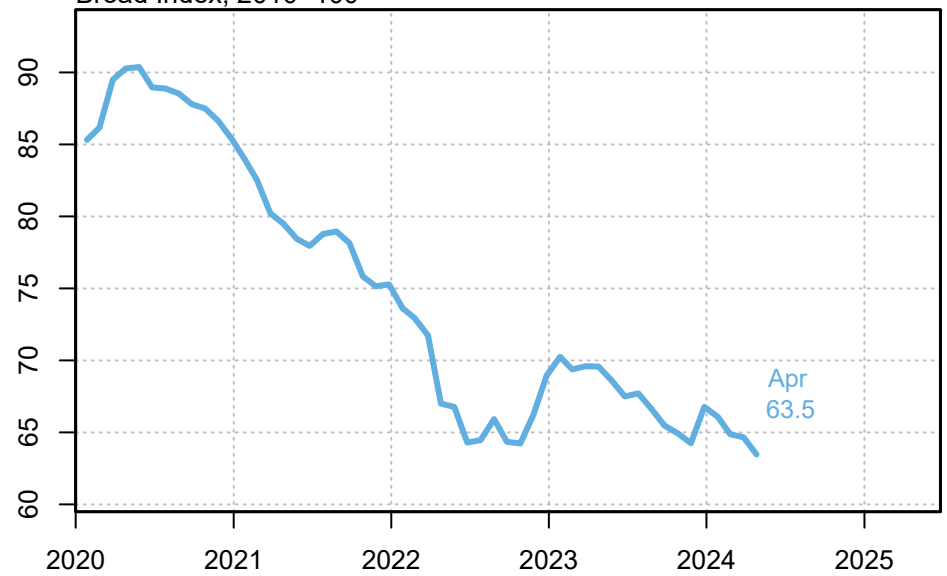

Broad Index, 2010=100

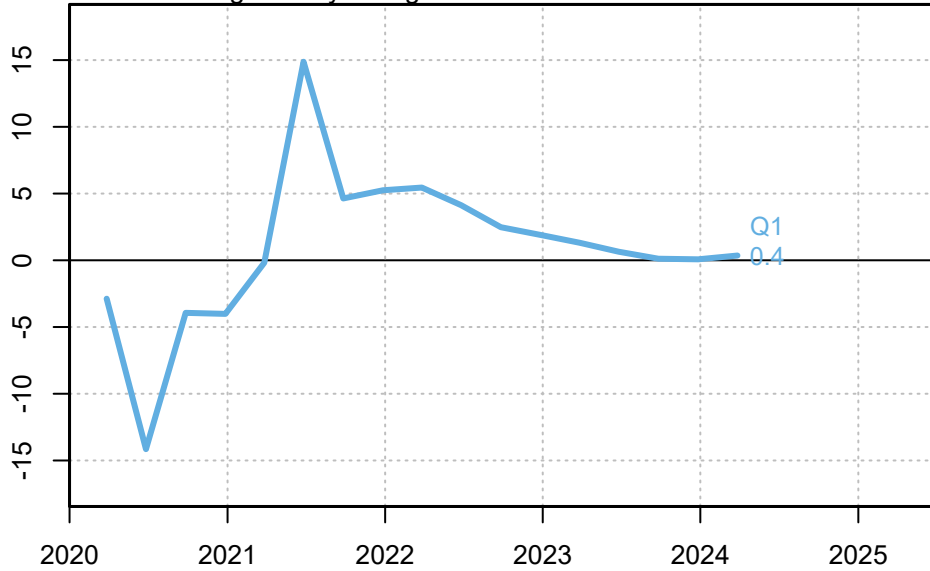

Annualized Quarterly Percentage Change



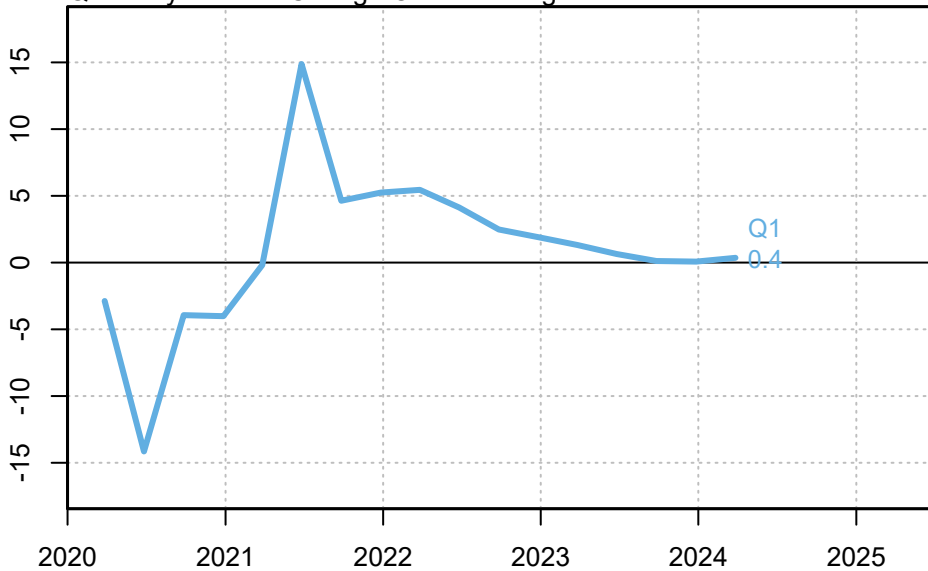

Retail Sales and Turnover



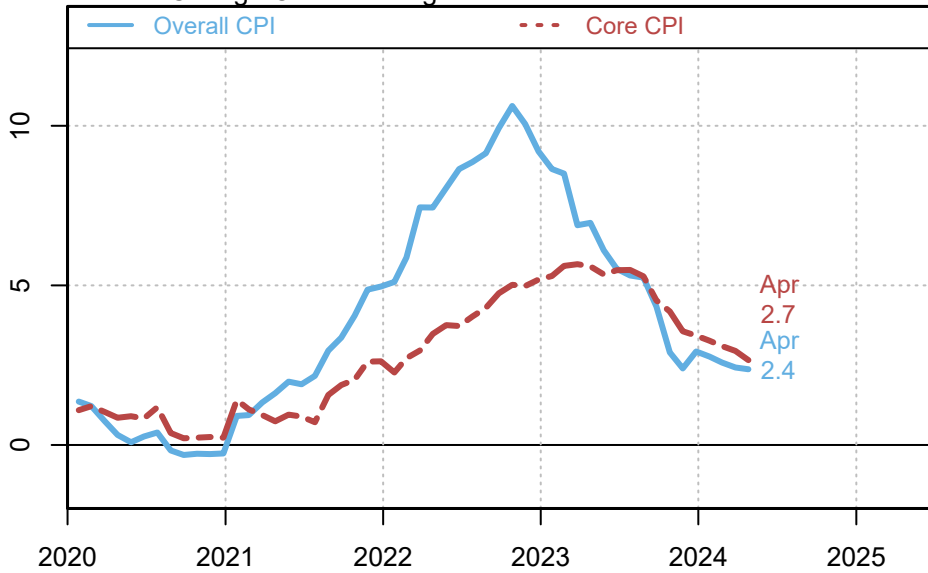

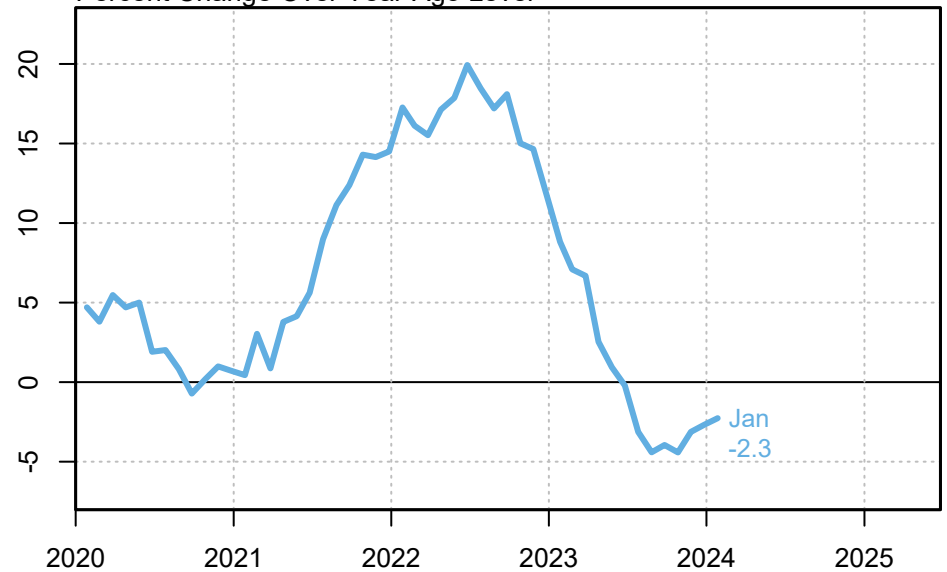
Producer Prices

Percent Change Over Year-Ago Level



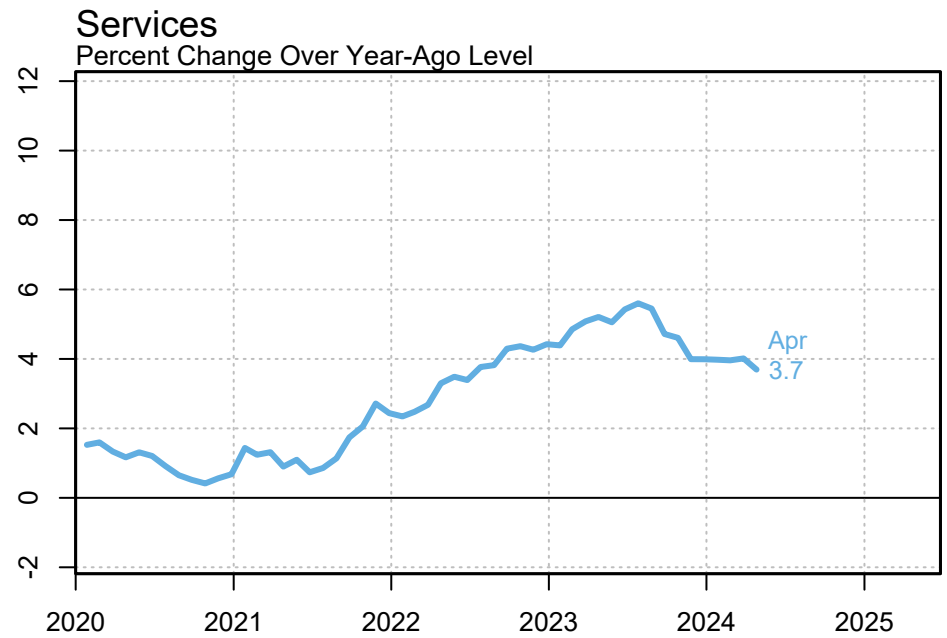
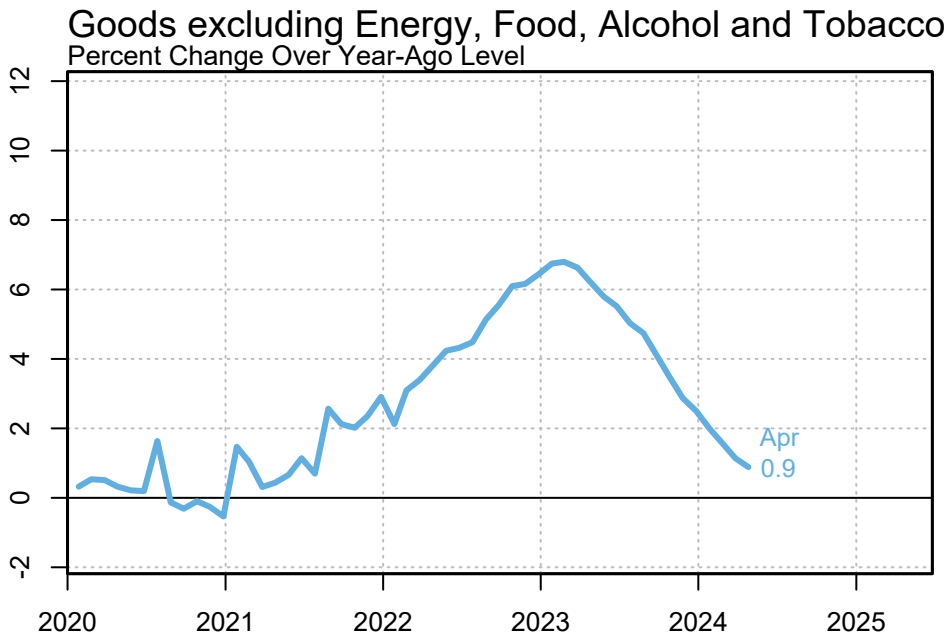
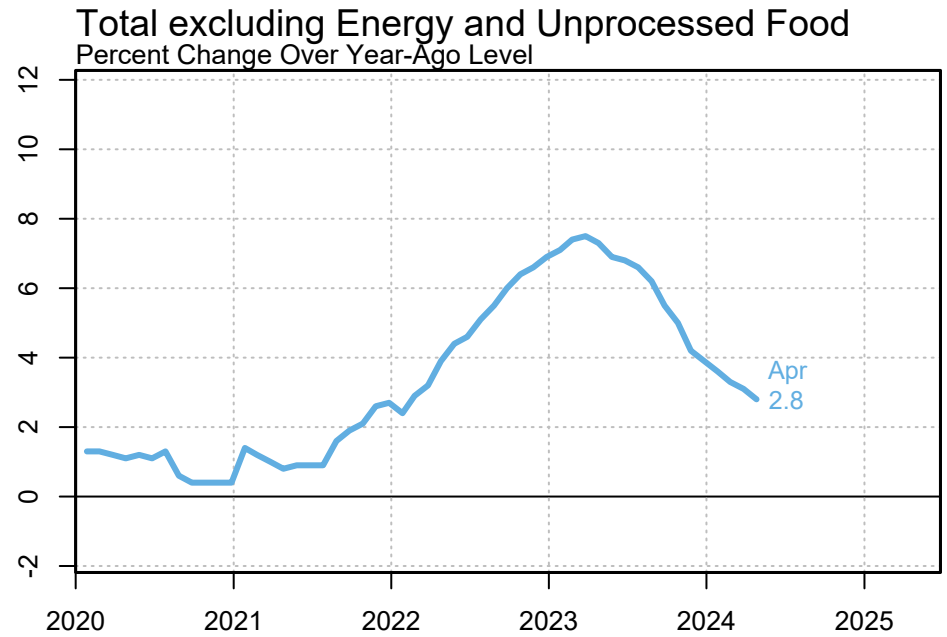
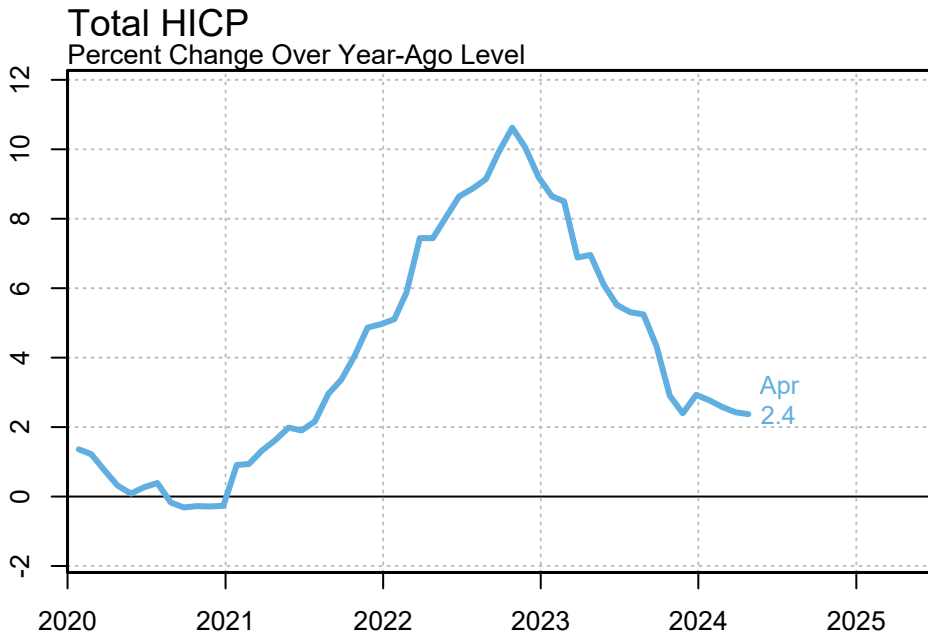

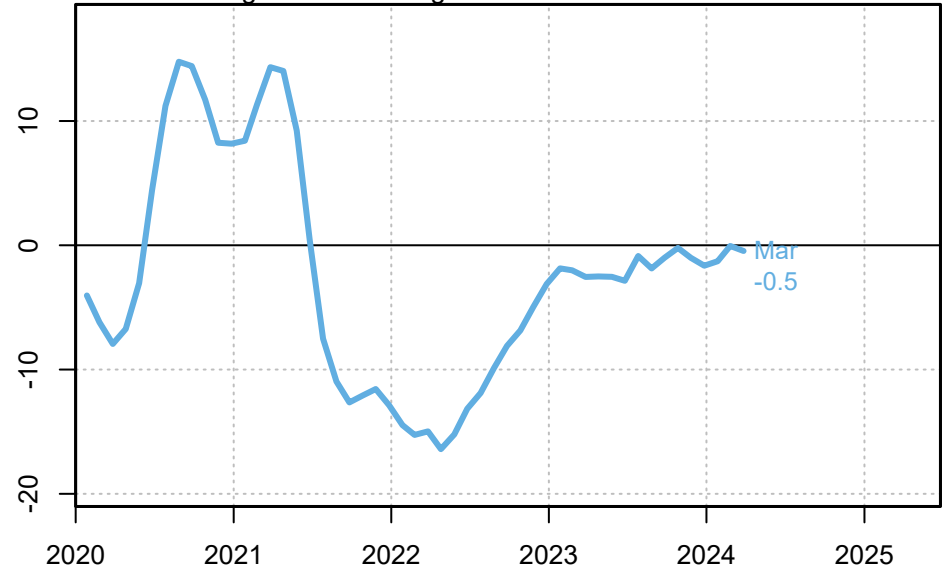
Harmonized Unemployment Rate

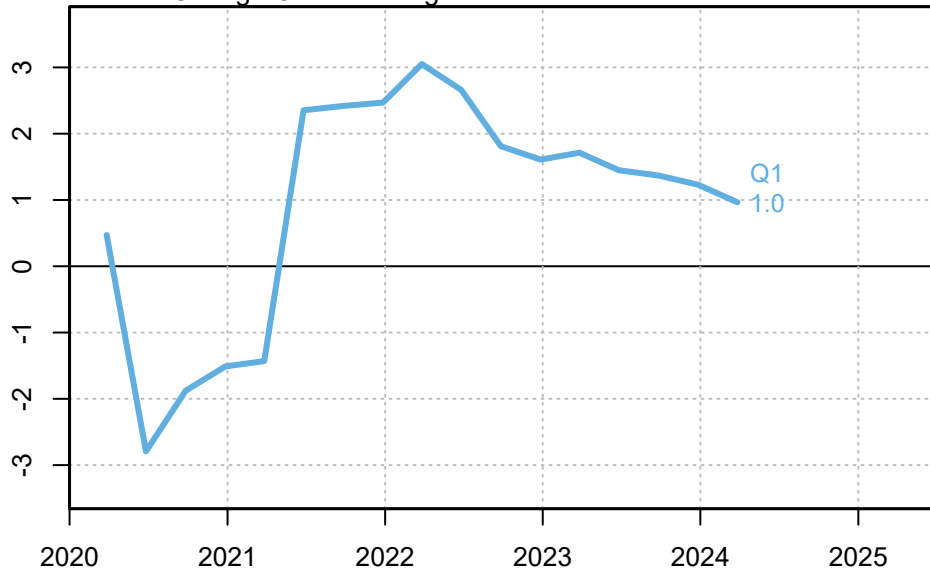
Harmonized Unemployment, Whole Economy

Percent Change Over Year-Ago Level



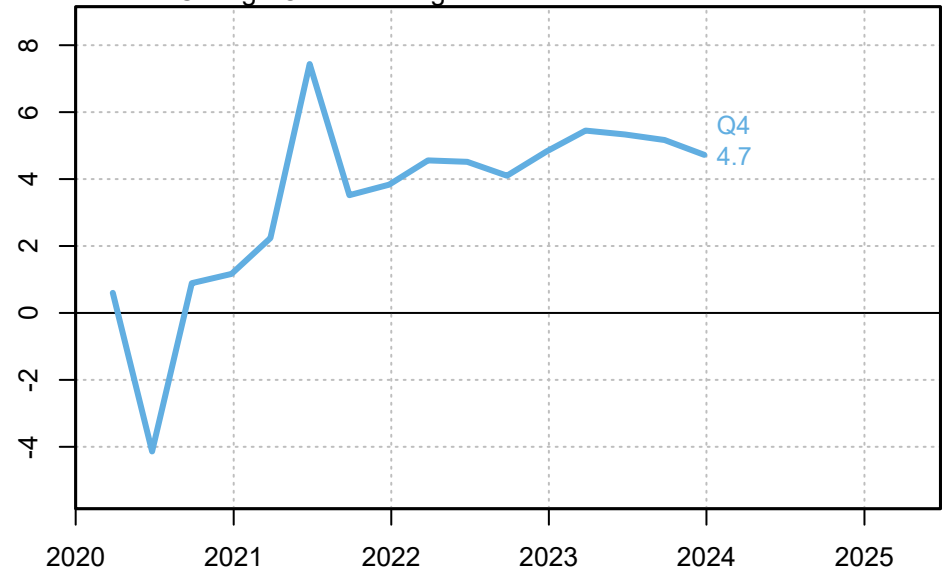
Employment in the Whole Economy

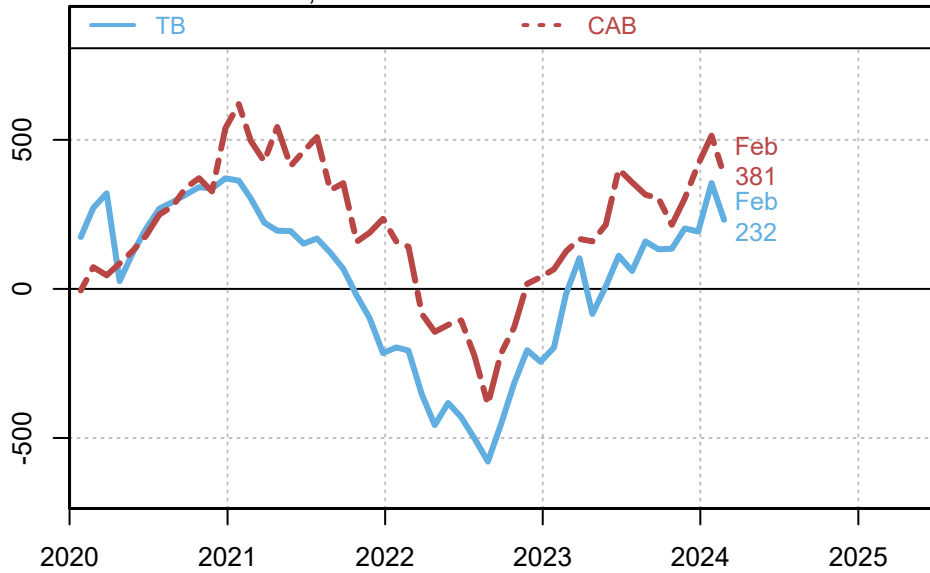

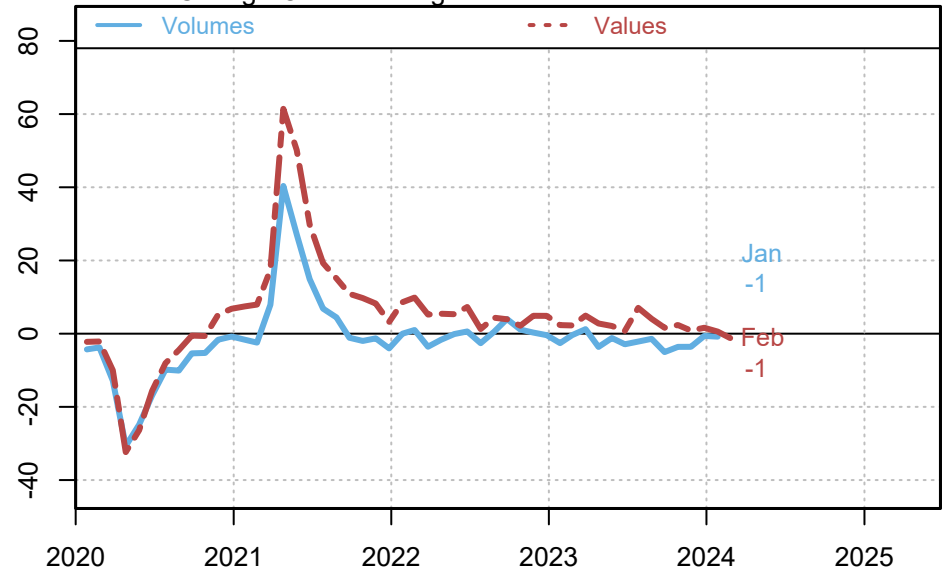

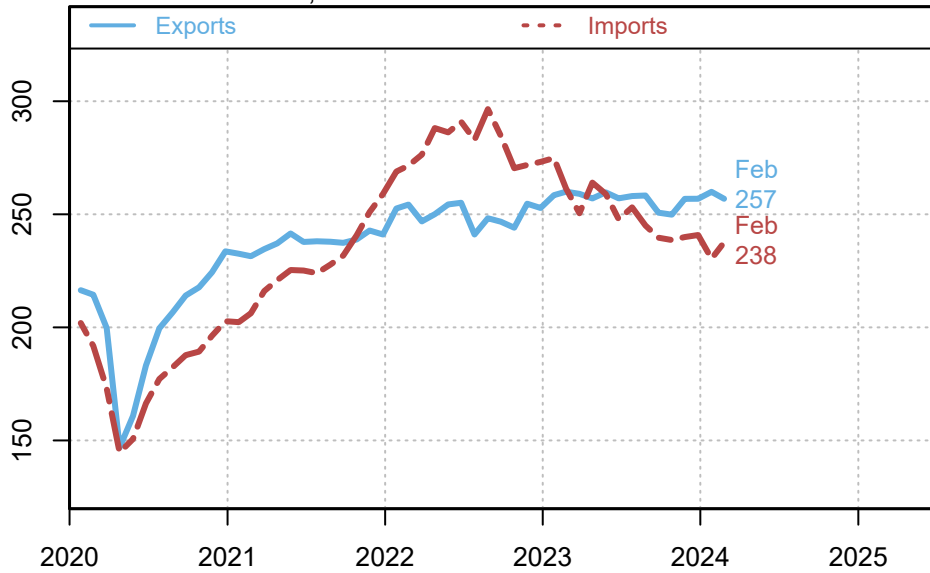
Total Exports

Percent Change Over Year-Ago Level



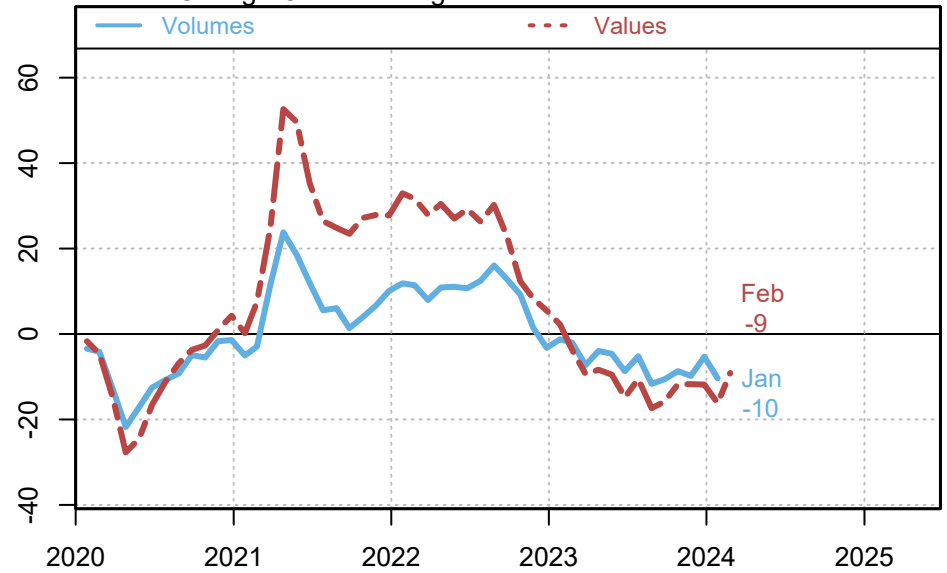

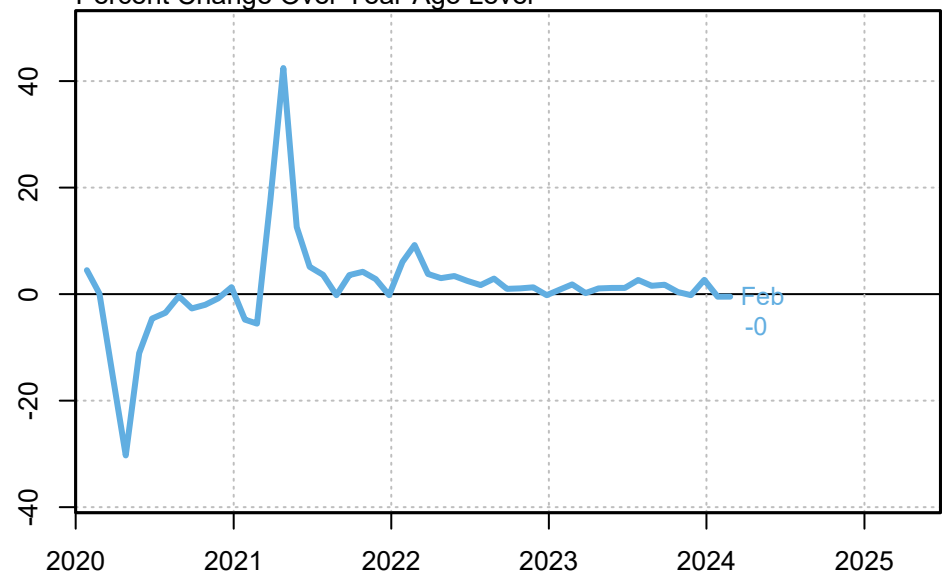
Manufacturing Output Percent Change Over Year-Ago Level

Real Effective Exchange Rate Narrow Index, 2010=100

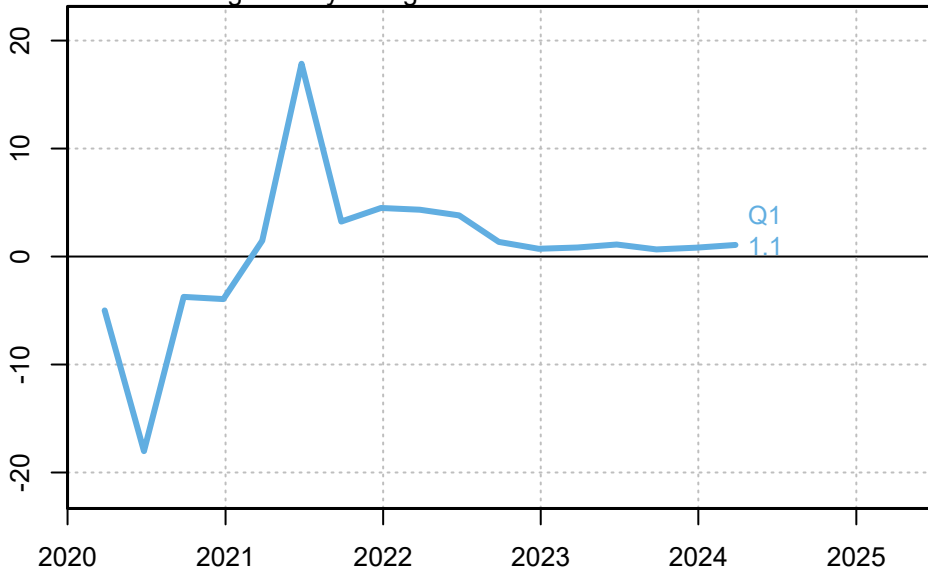

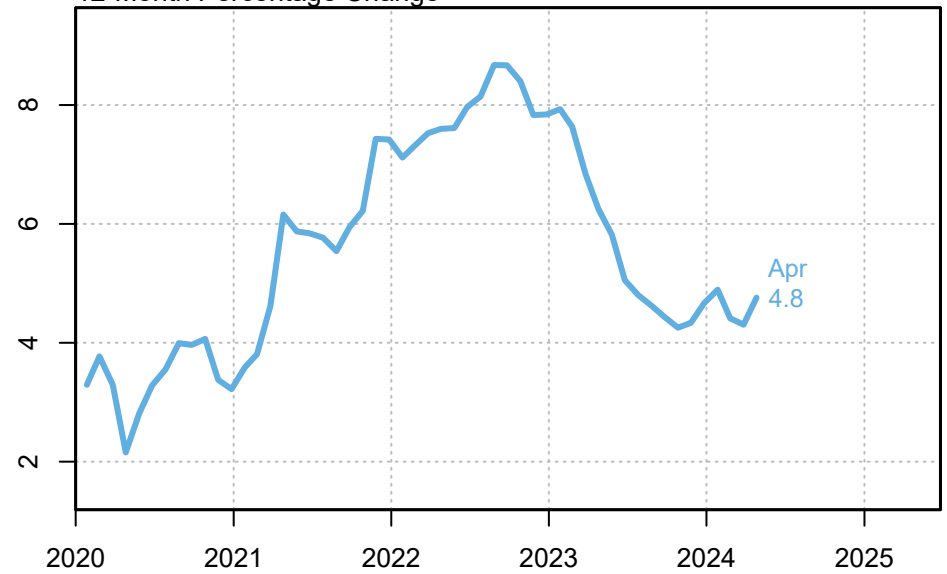
Urban Unemployment Rate

3-month Treasury Bill Rate



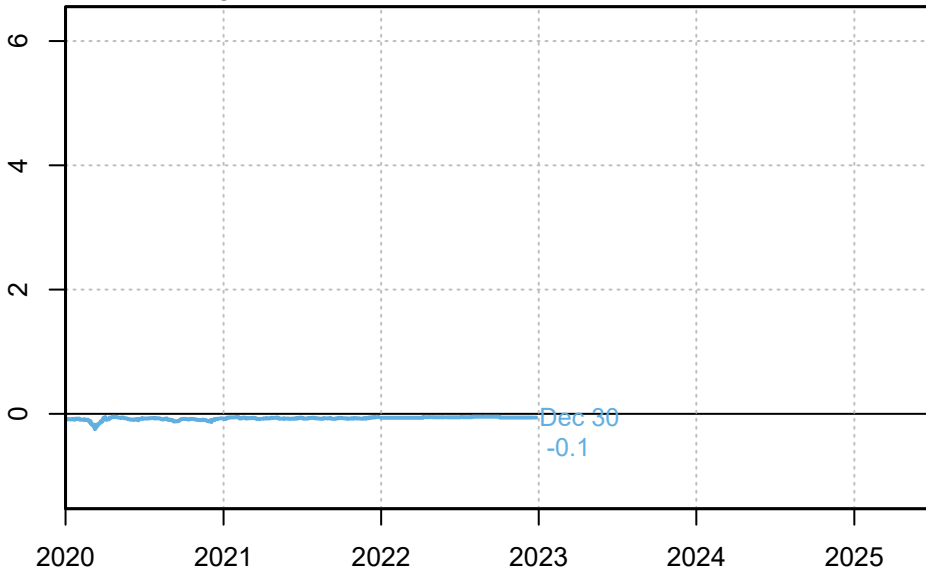
