Located just north of Albany in the Capital Region, the Glens Falls metropolitan area is one of New York's smallest metropolitan areas, with a population of more than 125,000. Manufacturing is an important source of jobs in the region, particularly a thriving medical devices segment, though manufacturing employment as a whole has been cut substantially since 1990. Growth in the health care sector has helped mitigate some of these losses. The area has a thriving leisure and hospitality sector, partly owing to Glens Falls' access to recreational attractions such as the Adirondack Mountains, Lake George, and nearby ski resorts.






Unemployment Rate by Metro Area











Unemployment Rate




Manufacturing Employment




Education & Health Employment
